## **Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 1282 prohibits children under 12 years of age from being placed in a juvenile detention facility unless all other alternatives have been exhausted and the child is charged with an offense that would be classified as a felony if committed by an adult. Further, the measure allows 13 and 14 year olds to be admitted to a juvenile detention facility if no alternatives exist, if the juvenile is charged with an offense that would be considered a felony if committed by an adult, and an assessment indicates the child requires detention.
