**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB1307 allows CLEET certified law enforcement officers employed by an institution within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education to become members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System (OLERS) if the officer is employed by an institution that makes an irrevocable election to become a participating employer in OLERS.

To become a participating employer in OLERS, the Board of Regents of the institution must provide a written election notice to OLERS. This election binds all qualifying police officers who are hired on or after the date of election as members of OLERS. Officers that are currently members of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma (OTRS) and were employed by the electing institution prior to the date of election have to option to remain in OTRS or make an irrevocable individual written election to participate in OLERS.
