Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB1308 clarifies the definition of “threatening behavior” at a school. The measure requires an officer or employee of a school district who notifies law enforcement of threatening behavior to comply with state and federal laws applicable to the release of student education records.

The committee substitute also requires a school district to develop a policy for determining if a student who engages in threatening behavior needs to complete a mental health assessment prior to returning to school.
