## **Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendments to HB1364 clarify that the career-readiness assessments are not mandatory and are to be administered at the discretion of each school district's administration.

The measure requires the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to review and approve career-readiness assessments that measure and document foundational workplace skills. The assessments are required to document readiness for a wide range of jobs and measure students' skills in applied mathematics, graphic literacy, and critical thinking among other things. The assessments are to be available to all public school districts in 2019-2020.
