**Research Analysis**

HB1416, as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Diversionary Court Funding Program Act. The measure creates the Oklahoma Diversionary Court Funding Program Revolving Fund. The fund will be available for the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to administer diversionary court programs. The fund will be comprised of monies from private prison contractors, through an imposed daily per diem rate of \$1/inmate, and a 100% match from the Legislature in state appropriations. The measure imposes the per diem cost on agreements beginning after November 1, 2019.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services estimates the provisions within HB 1416 would generate approximately \$4,300,000 and would be expected to fund 875 drug/ mental health court slots.
