Fiscal Analysis

After consideration with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB), it is determined that the agency would need to promulgate a rule designating the river a scenic river and the measure would generate an anticipated minimal impact to the agency. Additionally, statute requires the OWRB must consider the scenic river designation in their agency permitting activity, but would still have only a minimal impact anticipated to the agency.

The Department of Environmental Quality found that no current discharge permit holders would be affected by this measure. The agency anticipates \$0 fiscal impact.
