## **Research Analysis**

HB 1926 allows a school district to install, or contract with a private vendor, to install a video-monitoring system on a school bus to record vehicles unlawfully overtaking school buses. The registered owner of a vehicle in violation may be fined not less than \$100 with 75% of the fine deposited to the credit of the Cameras for School Bus Stops Revolving Fund. Monies from the fund may be expended by the State Board of Education for the purposes of providing grants to public school districts for the installation of camera equipment on buses.
