**Research Analysis**

HB 1969 provides federal law enforcement officers and municipal and state law enforcement officers employed in a county with a population in excess of 255,000 are not qualified to serve as jurors. The measure clarifies that jailers and municipal or state law enforcement officers are eligible to serve as jurors for noncriminal cases in counties with a population of less than 255,000.
