HB 1974 authorizes the court to have the authority to defer payment of all outstanding fines, courts costs and fees in a criminal case for any person who has served a period of incarceration after conviction; has been released from DOC; has complied with terms of probation or supervision; and has secured admission to and enrolled in an institution of higher education or career technology education.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1974, which creates permissive language to allow courts to waive fines for certain listed reasons, could have a revenue loss for the state. However, since the language of the measure is optional, the overall impact is contingent upon how often fines are waived by each county.
