Research Analysis

The SA's to HB 2009 restore title. The measure provides that a person who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent felony or offense which would require registration pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act and who is convicted of a second or subsequent nonviolent felony, may be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than the maximum sentence plus one-fourth of the maximum sentence that could have been imposed for a first conviction of the current offense. Currently, these persons are subject to twice the maximum sentence.
