Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2098 creates the 21st Century Motor Tag Agent Act. The measure prohibits a member or employee of the Tax Commission or any person related to a member or employee of the Tax Commission from appointment as a tag agent. The measure removes the prohibition on legislators or family members of legislators from being a tag agent. The measure increases the fine for a motor license agent or employee of an agent to operate a messenger or delivery service from \$1,000 to \$2,000. The measure provides that the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a notarized document is to be determined by Title 49. The measure modifies the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a license plate to be the cost of postage plus \$1.25. The measure modifies the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a decal to be the cost of postage plus \$1.
