Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2126 authorizes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to review or monitor all complaints of excessive force allegations made against law enforcement officers commissioned and employed by law enforcement agencies of this state. The OSBI is to be the sole agency authorized to review or monitor complaints of excessive force and is to conduct such reviews or monitoring only upon request by a law enforcement agency or the office of the district attorney in the county in which the excessive force allegation occurred.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2126, which authorizes OSBI to review and monitor complaints of excessive force when requested, is determined to have a negative impact on the agency. Increasing the agency's mission and duties will require more manpower: possibly a section of investigators (10 FTE).
