**Research Analysis**

The Conference committee substitute to HB 2307 requires a motor license agent to be open four hours per week in the evening hours or on Saturday, subject to approval by the Tax Commission. The Tax Commission may authorize a motor license agent to stay open a lesser period of time if the Tax Commission is satisfied that the public is being properly served. At least one motor license agent open in the evening or on Saturdays in each county.
