## **Research Analysis**

HB2330 exempts the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) from the provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. Further, the measure allows ODVA to give expenditure preference to veterans or veteran-owned businesses. No veteran or veteran-owned business may be considered a vendor with approval from the federal System for Award Management. The measure also modifies the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, requiring state agencies that contract with out-of-state companies for reasons other than lowest price to provide reasons why the out-of-state company was chosen over an Oklahoma company.
