**Research Analysis**

HB2330, as proposed committee substitute, exempts the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) from the provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. Further, the measure allows ODVA to give expenditure preference to veterans or veteran-owned businesses. No veteran or veteran-owned business may be considered a vendor with approval from the federal System for Award Management.
