HB 2363 authorizes the holder of a retail spirits license to serve free samples of spirits, wine and beer within the licensed premises and at public events. The retail spirits license holder may also hold events to promote, educate or entertain on or off the premises for which admission may be charged and at with spirits, wine or beer may be sold and consumed.
