Research Analysis

HB 2368 creates the Oklahoma Commission on Opioid Abuse. The 12-member commission chaired by the Attorney General is to study, evaluate and make recommendations for any changes to state policy, rules or statutes to better combat opioid abuse in Oklahoma. The commission is to prepare a report by December 31, 2019 and each year thereafter. The commission is dissolved July 1, 2023.
