Fiscal Analysis

The CS for HB 2483 removes two members of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Board, saving the agency approximately \$600 per year in travel expenses. The measure also modifies the appointing authority for the Board.

The measure also modifies the appointing authority for the Department's Commissioner, as well as the process by which the Commissioner's salary is to be fixed. The measure does not directly establish the salary of the Commissioner. It is unknown if the new process will result in increases or decreases in the Commissioner's salary for future years.
