Research Analysis

The CCR A to HB 2601 prohibits marijuana smoking or vaping in multiple locations including public spaces, educational facilities, and state-owned vehicles. The measure allows for medical marijuana smoking or vaping at research or treatment centers if integral to the research or treatment. The measure creates a short-term medical marijuana license valid for 60 days. The measure directs the State Department of Health to work with the State Banking Department to create banking practices upon federal action. The measure removes the restrictions that the State Department of Health not contract with vendors providing services to marijuana businesses and not store personally identifiable information. The measure allows publicly traded companies to hold a medical marijuana business license. Lastly, the measure modifies regulations relating to advertisement of marijuana products.
