**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2601 defines “physician” and requires the recommending physician to notify the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority if the patient no longer meets the requirements for a medical marijuana license. Lastly, the floor amendment adds an emergency.
