**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB2625 undo many of the changes that were made in the Engrossed version of the bill.

The Engrossed version of HB2625 deleted the requirement that traditionally certified public school superintendents, and alternatively certified public school superintendents receive a passing score on the subject area competency examination.

The Senate amendments reinstate these requirements.
