Research Analysis

HB2641, as introduced, creates a 16 member task force to study and make recommendations to the Legislature on changes to the units or sets of competencies required for students to graduate high school in Oklahoma. The measure outlines membership and appointment criteria to serve on the task force and provides a nonexclusive list of topics that may be studied by the task force. The task force must concludes its work and submit a report to the Governor, Legislature and chairs of the House and Senate education committee by December 31, 2020.
