**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2790 requires that any board or commission which has oversight of child welfare services within DHS, except the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, include one member who was a former foster youth and one member who was a birth parent of a child formerly adjudicated deprived and who was successfully reunified with the child.
