## **Research Analysis**

The PCS for HB 2792 amends the Oklahoma Registered Poultry Feeding Operations Act to require operators to renew nutrient management plans every six years with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF). An amendment may be submitted in lieu of a renewal if there have been no operational changes, such as the number of poultry or size of the facility, since the most recent nutrient management plan was approved by the department.
