Research Analysis

HB 2792 amends the Oklahoma Registered Poultry Feeding Operations Act to require operators to renew nutrient management plans every six years with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF). An amendment may be submitted in lieu of a renewal if there have been no operational changes, such as the number of poultry or size of the facility, since the original nutrient management plan was approved by the department. The measure requires ODAFF to compile and submit to the Legislature a report of the amount of poultry-waste land-applied on site, exported to another county, or exported to another state.
