Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2799 requires schools to administer the Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey to grades 6, 8, 10, and 12, with the purpose of providing direction to school districts and communities on how to improve the lives of students with respect to alcohol, tobacco, drug use, mental health, academic failure and violence.

Schools are required to first administer the survey in the 2021-2022 school year, and biennially after that. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services is directed to maintain the survey and provide technical assistance to schools when implementing the survey and developing prevention strategies.
