**Research Analysis**

HB 2799, as introduced, requires schools to administer the Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey with the purpose of measuring health risk behaviors such as violence, tobacco use, or alcohol and drug use, in order to form school prevention and intervention strategies. Schools are required to first administer the survey in the 2020-2021 school year, and biennially after that.

The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services is directed to maintain the survey and provide technical assistance to schools when implementing the survey and developing prevention strategies.
