Fiscal Analysis

HB 2879 in its current form amends Rule 2.43 of the Rules of the Ethics Commission to allow for candidate committees to expend funds to cover the costs of specific memorial highway or bridge naming signage pursuant to 69 O.S. § 1600.

After analysis, the permissive language of the measure indicates no direct impact to revenues or expenditures if passed.
