**Research Analysis**

The FA1 to HB 2883 provides a fishing license exemption to all guests of landowners or tenants who have received permission to fish in the owner or tenant's private pond, as long as the pond is 20 acres or less, is entirely within private property, and does not connect with public waters. The exemption does not apply to commercial fishing or fishing in ponds built, created, stocked, or supported by any state or federal public funds.
