## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2899, in its current form, allows state agencies to establish policies that would permit full-time classified and regular unclassified employees to take up to three (3) hours of administrative leave per week for the purposes of physical fitness and wellness. The rules covering the implementation of such policy shall be promulgated by OMES.

Upon analysis, this measure is estimated to have no impact on state revenues or expenditures.
