Research Analysis

HB 2912 directs the Department of Public Safety to modify its rules to allow a truck-tractor semi trailer combination which is greater than 90 feet in overall length to be accompanied by an escort on two-lane highways and modify rules to allow a combination other than a truck-tractor semi-trailer greater than 90 feet to be accompanied by an escort on two-lane highways or super two-lane highways. The measure removes the restriction of over-width or over-height equipment used in soil conservation from obtaining a permit to operate on Interstate highways.
