**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2927 authorizes DHS to create a pilot program that would assist any minors, who are separated from their parents or guardians but are not in the custody of DHS or any Indian tribe, to become self-reliant adults. The bill also provides that individuals receiving services from DHS as a part of the pilot may apply for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program using the income of the student rather than the parent.
