**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2975 creates the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp Remediation Program as an alternative to destroying hemp that has THC levels beyond the federal legal limit, .3 percent on a dry weight basis.

**Fiscal Analysis**

After analysis and discussion with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF), the agency offers its best estimate for maintenance program tracking in the remediation of “hot hemp.” The estimate of fiscal impact is based on the expectation of the significant increase in future hemp production and the work currently being done in program tracking. ODAFF anticipates the addition of one FTE with a salary benefit package, office, and equipment set up of approximately \$78,405.50.
