**Research Analysis**

HB 3027 requires nursing facilities to maintain liability insurance coverage of at least one million dollars for each occurrence of negligence. If a facility is unable to secure liability insurance, it is required to notify the patient, or patient's relative, that coverage is not provided and a form so indicating must be signed by the patient or relative. The measure further provides that the inability to obtain liability coverage does not indemnify the facility due to negligence.
