## **Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 3051 modifies the definitions of "rural resident" and "rural area" in the Rural Water, Sewer, Gas and Solid Waste Management Districts Act by increasing from 10,000 to 25,000 the population threshold of eligible municipalities. According to the 2010 Census, 718 of 733 Oklahoma cities had less than 25,000 people. The measure also increases the cap on the amount that rural water districts can charge per 1,000 gallons of water from 10 to 20 cents and allows the district to spend the money on water sustainability assessments.
