Research Analysis

HB 3059 allows retail spirits licensees to hold tasting parties during normal business hours. “Tasting party” is defined as an event for sampling a selection of spirits, wine, or beer. The tasting parties must be in a separate room or sectioned-off area and cannot allow persons under 21 years of age. Samples served at the tasting parties must be free, and alcoholic beverages sold must be in their original sealed packages.
