## **Research Analysis**

HB 3070 requires persons assisting in prenatal, labor and delivery, or postpartum care outside of a hospital to be licensed as certified trained midwives under the Oklahoma Board of Nursing. The measure defines the scope of midwifery. Licensed midwives must be supervised by a physician, provide a plan to the mother that includes selecting a hospital in the case of an emergency, and inform the selected emergency room. The Oklahoma Board of Nursing is directed to promulgate rules.
