Research Analysis

HB 3088 requires hospitals providing inpatient maternity services and birthing centers to provide implicit bias training. Maternal health care professionals must complete the training at least every two years and receive certification upon completion. The State Department of Health is directed to promulgate rules.

Fiscal Analysis

The Health Department states HB 3088 would potentially cost up to \$40k the first year and up to \$20k for years 2-5. There could be further costs associated with this bill if we had to do an alternative training outside the trainer format.

The Health Department could receive grant funds if they are able to set up the training required in this bill by September.
