**Research Analysis**

HB 3095 creates a certificate of registration to permit the registered person to engage in the activities of a used motor vehicle salesperson and removes the requirement for used motor vehicle salesperson's licenses.. The cost of the registration for each salesperson \$50 to be renewed biennially and, for a transfer, \$25. A salesperson shall be deemed to be temporarily approved and allowed to sell vehicles when applications and fees are on file with the Commission. The measure modifies who is required to maintain a certificate of registration from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission in order to sell motor vehicles. The measure allows a used motor vehicle dealer's license to authorize one person to sell without a certificate of registration if the person is the owner of a proprietorship or the person designated as the principal in the dealer's franchise or the managing officer or partner.
