**Research Analysis**

HB 3135 provides that if the court finds that a minor convicted as an adult was sexually abused within one year of committing the offense, the court may depart from the mandatory minimum sentencing, suspend any portion of applicable sentencing, or transfer the minor to the jurisdiction of the court's juvenile division.
