**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3176 allows the board of county commissioners to have the power to establish and enforce fines and penalties for violation of its health, inspection, property maintenance and building regulations. The measure provides that when issuing a citation, delivery of the citation may be delivered personally, by certified mail, registered mail, or posted in a conspicuous place in or about the property where the violation occurred. The measure provides that repeated violations on the cited property may result in an increase of the fine up to \$1,000 per violation.
