Research Analysis

HB 3195 directs all sheriffs, jailers and deputies and other law enforcement agencies to comply with any request made in an immigration detainer request provided by the federal government and inform persons identified in the immigration detainer that they are being held pursuant to the request. A sheriff, jailer or deputy is not required to comply if the person has provided proof that the person is a citizen of the United States.
