Research Analysis

HB 3211 directs the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth (OCCY) to create a grievance process for children detained in adult detention facilities. OCCY is directed to investigate grievances and notify the Department of Human Services (DHS) whenever a grievance is received about a child who is in DHS custody. The measure also directs any facility detaining children to make the grievance policies available. The measure excludes children held in Department of Corrections custody.
