**Research Analysis**

HB 3216 modifies the responsibilities of the Office of Juvenile System Oversight within the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth. The measure deletes the cap on the number of inspections that may be conducted on state-operated children's facilities and authorizes the office to conduct site visits of facilities within the children and youth service system.
