Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3236 creates the “Seizure Safe Schools Act” and requires each school to have one employee who is trained to recognize the signs of a seizure and administer or assist with the self-administration of seizure rescue medicine.

Before a school employee can administer seizure rescue medicine to a student, the parent or guardian shall provide the school with a written statement authorizing the school employee to administer the medicine, provide a written statement from the student’s health care provider with details about the medicine and the student’s condition, and provide the school with medicine in a sealed package. The parent or guardian must also work with the school employee to create a seizure action plan.
