**Research Analysis**

HB 3253 authorizes a board of county commissioners to determine how many years of service may qualify a full-time county employee for a continuing education program. The bill further expands the continuing education program that may be offered to county employees to include other in-state or out-of-state programs or courses relevant to the employee's responsibilities. The measure also makes an employee ineligible for the program if they have been formally disciplined prior to submitting an application.
