Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3255 changes the waiver amounts that high school students concurrently enrolled in college courses are entitled to receive.

Instead of receiving a tuition waiver for the amount of resident tuition, a high school student would receive the lesser of:

- The actual amount of resident tuition for the credit hours enrolled, or
- The average amount of resident tuition of all the community junior colleges in the state
