**Research Analysis**

HB 3271, as introduced, directs counties to establish an online bidding process. The process would include a designated opening and closing time, real-time posting and updating of online bids, authorization to require bidders to register before the opening date and to agree to terms and conditions, authorization to determine criteria used to award the contract, and authorization to determine whether it is in the best interest of the county to allow an electronic bid after the official closing time due to significant error or event.
