HB3286, as introduced, increases, from 7000 to 9500, the population limit for cities, towns and unincorporated areas that are eligible to receive monies pursuant to the Rural Economic Action Plan (REAP). REAP is a state appropriated funding program for small, rural communities with populations below the population limits qualifier.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3286 in its current form increases the number of municipalities eligible to participate in certain Rural Economic Action Plan grant programs. The measure only deals with eligibility to participate in the grant programs. The measure does not increase the total size of the grant programs. For these reasons HB 3286 in its current form is not expected to impact the state budget or revenues.
