HB 3292 allows any three or more farm vehicles owned by the same person and previously registered in this state may be registered at the same time regardless of the month or months in which they were previously registered.

Fiscal Analysis

A minimal decrease in motor vehicle collections is estimated due to issuance of credits in the first year to combine registration periods of personalized or specialty plates with the standard issue plate.

Additional administrative costs of \$58,000 related to programming and motor vehicle system modifications are anticipated.
